NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- **1.3** Appendix T will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the P Class and Starling Class
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry at www.qcyc.org.nz and depositing the required entry fee to Westpac 03 1710 0010072 00
- 3.3 Completed entries and fully paid entry fees must be received by Thursday 30th November 2017.
- 3.4 Late entries, accompanied by the contest entry fee plus the late entry fee may be accepted at the race committee's discretion until 0900 hours on Saturday 2nd December 2017.

- To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant's national authority.
- **3.6** For sailors that enter this event and are residents of Nelson or Marlborough you will be automatically be additionally entered in the Nelson Marlborough Championships.

- 4.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1530

5 FEES

5.1 Required fees are as follows

5.2 Other fees: Late entries will be accepted up to the close of registration with the additional fee of \$25.



6 MEASUREMENT

6.1 Each boat may be required to produce a valid measurement certificate.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 1800 on 26th November 2017 at www.qcyc.org.nz.

8 VENUE

8.1 Races will be sailed on the waters of Queen Charlotte Sounds.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed may be any combinations of Trapezoid, Triangle/Windward/Leeward and/or Windward/Leeward legs.

10 SCORING

10.1 4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2

- a) When fewer than 4 have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When 4 to 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Support vessels shall be registered with the organizing authority

12 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from QCYC / Shelly Beach.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
