**Rule 1.7 is added:**

“1.7 The event is being run under the Ministry of Health Covid 19 Level 2 Guidelines. Nelson Yacht Club does not take the responsibility of running the event under the Level 2 guidelines lightly. Competitors and their supporters must comply with all instructions issued by the club to comply with the Covid 19 guidelines. Failure to do so will result in action against the sailor and/ or their supporters, which may include suspension from the event.”

**Rule 2 is changed to read:**

“2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the electronic noticeboard: [‘2020Starlingnationals’ on Team App](#). Failure to read the electronic noticeboard will not be grounds for redress.

2.2 Flag L ashore is changed to "A notice has been posted on the electronic noticeboard"

**Rule 6.1 is changed to read:**

“There will be no Briefing. Skippers are encouraged to ensure they have read and understand the Sailing Instructions and any amendments. Any questions to the Race Committee may be submitted via email to [manager@nelsonyachtclub.org.nz](mailto:manager@nelsonyachtclub.org.nz). Answers will be provided as a notice on the electronic noticeboard”

**Rule 11.3 is added:**

“Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during the starting sequence for other races. [DP]”

**Rule 16.1 is changed to read:**

“Protest forms will be available on the clipboard with the contact tracing register in each ‘bubble’. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered by sending a photo of the protest form to [manager@nelsonyachtclub.org.nz](mailto:manager@nelsonyachtclub.org.nz) prior to the end of the protest time limit.”

**Rule 16.2 is changed to read:**

“Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held over Zoom or as directed by the chair of the protest committee.

For any hearings to be held over Zoom the protest committee will send an invite to all parties and witnesses listed by email. It is a competitor’s responsibility to ensure they have the means to attend a Zoom meeting. Failure to attend will not be grounds for Redress or Reopening RRS 62 and 66. Hearings may be held before the close of protest time.”

**Rule 16.7 is changed to read:**

“Breaches of SIs 1.7, 4.4, 19, 22, and 25 will not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).”

### **Rule 23.1 is changed to read:**

“All Starlings shall be launched from Nelson Yacht Club ramp unless instructed otherwise. Launching will be controlled as necessary to ensure physical distancing. All competitors must comply with instructions from NYC volunteers”

### **Rule 23.2 is changed to read:**

“Competitors will be issued with a numbered flag corresponding to their Tag, which shall be attached to the trolley of their boat.”

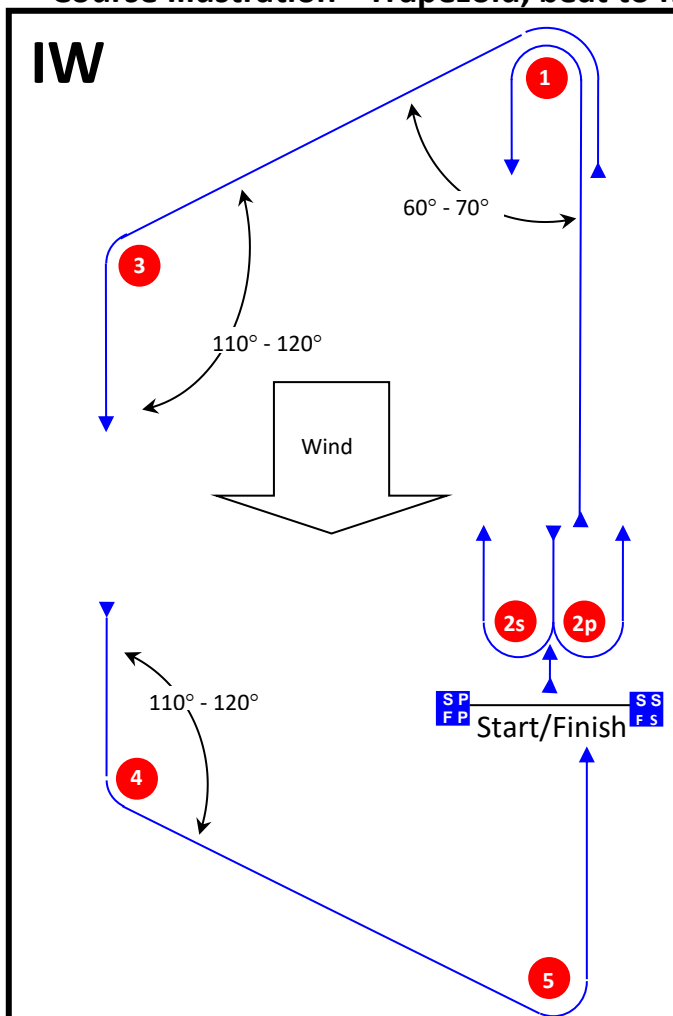

Course Illustration – Trapezoid, beat to finish – signal boat for start/finish

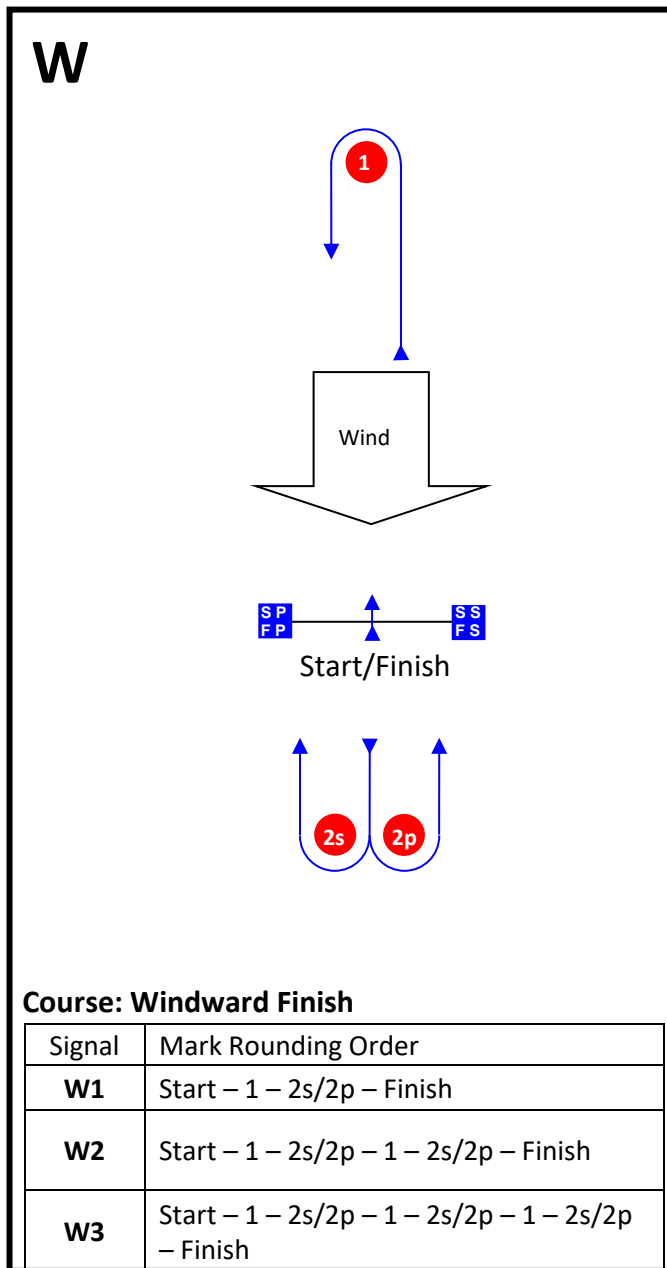


Course: Inner Trapezoid with beat to finish

Signal	Mark Rounding Order
IW1	Start – 1 – 3 – 4 – 5 – Finish
IW2	Start – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – 3 – 4 – 5 – Finish
IW3	Start – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – 3 – 4 – 5 – Finish
IW4	Start – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – 3 – 4 – 5 – Finish

Mark	Description
1	Red Cylindrical – Tall/narrow
2s 2p	Red Cylindrical – Short/Wide (Extraordinary Nelson Tasman)
3 4 5	Red Cylindrical – Tall/narrow
SS Starting mark starboard end	Race Committee signal vessel
SP Starting mark port end	Race Committee vessel
FS Finishing mark starboard end	Race Committee signal vessel
FP Finishing mark port end	Race Committee vessel
